In November 2024, the Sierra Vista Park shelter was destroyed by arson, leaving Northwest Reno with one less gathering space. Now, we have an opportunity to come together and rebuild it more strongly than before.

Rebuilding the Sierra Vista Park shelter is estimated to cost **200,000**, covering demolition, construction materials, labor, and other costs. We need your help to bring this vision to life.

Cost Breakdown:

\$105,000 – Construction materials (steel frame, fire-resistant roofing, concrete foundation)

\$50,000 – Labor and installation

\$15,000 – Site preparation and landscaping restoration
